

After registration, the IRS Job Placement Counselor will meet individually with the client to help identify his/her knowledge, skills, strengths and particularly his/her needs. Once the client's objectives have been established they are referred to the suitable services. The Job Placement Counselor also plays an important role with following up the referred clients to job opportunities to see how they are doing and to assist them in solving any problems in the working place. Basic psychological counseling is also conducted to restore the mental status of the clients if they suffer from feeling of hopeless, loneliness or other distress feelings which is common among people with disabilities.
