For the academic year 2008-2009, for instant, IRS Program has a great honor to get a full scholarship from **Samdech Dekchor Hun Sen**, Prime Minister of the Royal Government of Cambodia, through the Council of Ministers for about 20 students with disabilities to continue their study at different private universities in Phnom Penh and some provinces across the country to pursue their study to get Bachelor Degrees.
