This course also helps the trainees to prepare a CV and to be well-prepared candidate for the job interview. *The Small Business* course has mainly been conducted for any persons with disabilities who are interested in starting a small business on his/her own. This course was also designed to help the trainees to know the types of business, to make a balance sheet and to know how to extend their business.
