

**Health:** This component is focus on prevention, medical care, rehabilitation, and assistive devices. Sometimes, pwds do not receive appropriate services because they do not go to health center when they detect early signs of health problems. They could also have diseases, injuries and may difficult for them to get to the health and rehabilitation service centers due to transport difficulties, geographical considerations or cost. Whenever health and rehabilitation services are needed but not available at community level, referrals towards the most appropriate service providers are arranged in co-ordination between CDC members and relevant agencies. The program staff disseminates information and coaches the committee members where service available but also provides or pays for transport, allowance to him/her to accompany pwds and families, for accommodation when needs and or medical fees when requires. In monthly basis, CDC member continues referral pwds to hospital based on the doctor appointment for case following up and regular medication (who has epileptic fit). 500 times of referrals will be made this period by ensuring pwds are able to access healthcare, physical rehabilitation, and other specialized services. For Aid to Daily Living (ADL) is assessed and if applicable, 150 ADLs will make and or purchase and provides by the committee members. Sometimes make it at home in collaboration between CDC members and parents. These ADLs produce at low cost, foster independence in adult and enable children to develop at their own pace. Sometimes they will receive assistive device from rehab-center. CDC member go along with the pwds aims to get closely link with service providers. 15 malnourished children will receive supplement food in case of disability prevention but program requires recommendation letter from the commune health center. The possibility of toilets/ramps/railings will assess and install where providing facility to pwd in commune level such as commune office, commune health center, school, and pagoda. This period, program plans to build 15 toilets/ramps/railings in pwds houses and public places. 6 houses of pwds will be renovated. These works will care by the committee members and contribution from the community; program will provide the construction materials.
