

Livelihood: Disability adds to the risk of impoverishment, and the conditions of poverty add to the risk of disability. Most of pwds often face impoverishment; it is a denial of the freedom and opportunity to develop a human being, and difficult in finding a job. The program staff make sure that pwds in target areas are able to develop skills in order to develop livelihood opportunities. Skills training for pwds involve building confidence and changing people's views in terms of how they see themselves, and how families and community see them. This component is focus on self-employment and financial support.
